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

Keep workers in the flow


We do our best work when we don't have to switch between apps to get things done. With tools available through Teams, it's easier for everyone to stay focused and organised.

Record, transcribe and translate

Using Teams, it's easy to record meetings and calls to capture audio, video and shared screens. There's also an option to create automatic transcriptions, so team members can play back meeting recordings with closed captions or search the transcript to find something specific.

Recordings are saved in Teams or OneDrive for easy and secure sharing, and attendees can also have transcriptions translated to the language of their choice.

Teams comes with enterprise-grade management capabilities so you can configure and set policies for teams or individuals, dependent on business needs. Plus, you control the features and settings within the app, from meetings, messaging and calling to live events and guests, using one Teams admin centre.

Built-in security and compliance

In 2021, the company announced a commitment to invest an additional USD 20 billion over the next five years to develop advanced security tools.


Instead of spending the first few minutes of every meeting just making sure everyone had successfully connected, meeting participants can get down to business right away.



Right-size your meeting spaces with greater flexibility


One of the most difficult aspects of arranging hybrid meetings is trying to make sure everyone can see, hear and distinguish their colleagues, no matter the size of the group or the location of the participants. Broadcasting a company-wide webinar is vastly different from holding a brainstorming session or a meet-and-greet for new hires. Setting visual and audio controls to optimise for one type of meeting can confound users when they switch to a different format.

From small focus rooms to large conference rooms, Teams Rooms is scalable and flexible to meet the various needs of all your organisation's meeting spaces. As a comprehensive, shared-space solution, meetings are easy for IT to deploy, manage and keep data secure. Artificial intelligence is integrated into meeting experiences, devices and management capabilities, bringing people closer together and saving your organisation – from business productivity to IT – time and money. Teams Rooms devices are available to suit a wide variety of business needs form factors, from highly modular kits that can be scaled to meet any room size to integrated solutions that combine the computer, microphone, speaker and camera into a single device that's compact and easy to deploy.





Small rooms are an ideal way for three to five people to share spontaneous ideas on whiteboards, either within Teams or through integrated whiteboarding devices like Surface Hub 2S.



Medium-size rooms can connect as many as 11 people on-site, with many more attending online.



Large rooms, designed for 18 or more people, enable you to add a second screen to make sure everyone can see participants and content. You can also use a smart camera to automatically bring speakers into view.

Joining and sharing are easy

Participants can reserve a Teams Room in Outlook, Teams or from a Teams panel and can join with a single touch on a computer, phone or tablet. Once in the room, anyone can share content from their personal device, with no cables, wires or controller needed. They can even use a shared digital canvas to sketch out ideas for all to see.


With a content camera and AI processing, attendees can also display physical objects, such as whiteboards or books, which will appear clear and vibrant on any screen. Microsoft speaker recognition technology lets everyone know who is speaking and lists their name in the transcript, so team members can focus on the meeting, not on taking notes.


Everyone gets a front row seat

Along with other options, Teams Rooms includes the front row meeting layout, which displays all participants at eye level – just as you would see them in person – rather than stacking headshots. Team members can simultaneously display content as well.

Enjoy high-res video, people recognition, active tracking and room view for enhanced inclusivity with MultiStream and Cloud IntelliFrame. Remote attendees get a clearer view of in-room participants, making conversations more engaging to elevate your hybrid meetings.

Chat comments are displayed on the side and can be sized for any screen, including a large conference room screen, ensuring everyone can read them. A convenient handraise button encourages participation.





Flexible and scalable for everyone

Employees don't have to worry about learning unfamiliar tools since they can continue using Teams for audio and video controls. Teams Rooms doesn't just work within Teams. With Direct Guest Join, participants can also attend meetings hosted outside of Microsoft.



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Flexible calling, fewer distractions

Even if they have a desk with a traditional phone, today's employees get work done in more places than ever. By replacing a legacy phone system with Teams Phone, you can make voice calls available in more places while potentially reducing costs.

Teams Phone gives you the flexibility to make and receive calls in the office, at home or on the go, across the devices that keep you connected and productive. Regardless of whether you're using a computer, desk phone, shared phone or mobile device, Teams Phone makes it easy to start a voice or video call from the Calls tab, Teams directory, phone number or Microsoft 365 contact card. You can even start a call from a chat with a single click.

Capabilities such as call history, voicemail, recording and transcription, and transfers are familiar and intuitive, while advanced controls such as auto attendants, call queues and voice-enabled channels help ensure calls are routed with efficiency.

Teams Phone uses AI to make calling smarter. For example, voice isolation and background noise suppression use AI to reduce distractions and improve focus, while AI helps identify and decline potential spam calls, improving workplace security and productivity. Copilot in Teams Phone uses AI to work more flexibly and intelligently, automating important administrative tasks of a call, such as capturing key points, task owners and next steps, so you can stay focused on the content.

Teams Phone integrates with Teams-certified contact centre solutions, enables telephony in custom applications and powers click-to-call functionality on websites to enable omni-channel customer engagement. Additionally, IT can manage everything in one centralised dashboard.




Enable advanced protection
